## The Eagles Mere Inn Fact Sheet

### Eagles Mere Inn:

The only Eagles Mere B&B within walking distance of this small Pennsylvania town's quaint shops and historic homes, the Eagles Mere Inn provides guests with a central location to enjoy both this tiny village "trapped in time" and the pristine air and the unparalleled natural beauty of the Northeastern Pennsylvania mountains.

### Inn Location:

Located atop the Pocono Endless Mountains of Northeastern Pennsylvania – just 400 paces from a lovely, clear lake surrounded by hundreds of acres of forest, incredible waterfalls, sunsets, skiing, and hiking. Two state parks – Ricketts Glen and World's End are a short drive away.

### History:

Eagles Mere Inn was built in 1887 by A.C. Little. It was constructed to be a bed and breakfast and has been running as such ever since. It is the last inn still operating from the town's height of popularity in the early 1900s. Renovated and refurbished in 2000, the inn offers historic charm blended with the amenities of today.

### All-Inclusive Accommodations:

The Inn features 19 rooms and suites in two historic buildings in the heart of town. Our tastefully decorated accommodations are available in eight rate ranges. Although they vary in size and style, each includes:

- A private bath
- A five-course gourmet dinner each night
- A hearty breakfast each morning
- Access to all the facilities of charming Eagles Mere Lake
- Use of our game room, with pool table, ping pong and darts
- Access to the tennis courts across the street
- Free use of the inn's bikes, kayaks, canoe, tennis equipment, ice skates, and cross-country skis
- Free wireless Internet access

### Restaurant:

The acclaimed dining room is open 8:00-10:00 a.m. for a breakfast, 6:30 pm to 9:00 for dinner. For overnight guests, a five-course meal is included in the room rate. The Inn's graceful dining room offers the perfect setting for an elegant evening in the Pennsylvania countryside.

Menus are not about the latest trend but about real food prepared well. The food reflects the Endless Mountains locale and the inn's commitment to use the best that is local, the best that is Pennsylvania.

*Note: Non-overnight dinner guests are taken by reservation only when space is available.*

### Rates:

Room rates vary between \$149 to \$259 per night, depending on room type and season. Rates include two meals for two people each day. 15% service charge, 6% state sales tax and 3% room tax are additional.

**From East:** Interstate 80 west, to Route 42 north (exit 232 Buckhorn), to Eagles Mere.

**From West:** Route 80 east, to Route 220 north, to Route 42 north, to Eagles Mere.

**From South:** Route 11 north, to Route 147 north, which turns into Route 180, continue to Rt. #405 north then Route 220 north, to Route 42 north, to Eagles Mere.

**From North:** From Routes #17, #86 and #6 take Route 220 south through Dushore, to Route 42 south (turn south at Laporte), to Eagles Mere.

**In Eagles Mere:** Start downtown at the Famous Clock, go towards Laporte (north on Route 42), take your second right (Mary Street) and go one block down hill to the inn.

8 a.m. to 10 p.m. The desk is closed and a machine records messages from 10 p.m. to 8 a.m., unless guests notify inn that they expect an emergency call.
